2.2 CONNECTIONS

Connecting the power cable

Insert the plug of the power cable into the power socket.

Press "OK" to confirm program selection, press "EXIT" return to hide menu



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




4.1.1 Manual Search





- Check the brightness level of TV. · Check the channel that is on air.

No or bad signal message appears · Check other device connected between antenna and the receiver, or adjust the antenna position

Poor Picture & sound quality

- Install antenna where there is not obstacle ahead.
